#### Q: IS HEP TIME LIKE REAL DOLLARS?

A: HEP time is not the same as cash; however, in some situations, some items may be purchased with Time Dollars. This topic will be covered in more detail during your orientation.

#### Q: HOW DO I EARN MORE HOURS?

A: You earn hours by accepting requests on the HEP website. You can search to find a relevant request and respond to see if the listing is a good fit for both parties.

#### Q: IS HEP SAFE?

A: Yes. Our members use great judgement and post listings at their own comfort level.

#### Q: WHAT CAN I OFFER?

A: More than you think! If you're stuck trying to think of your first offer, take a look through HEP requests to get an idea for what people need.

#### Q: WHY SHOULD I DONATE?

A: HEP is a member-run organization that uses your donation to cover the minimal overhead needed to run operations.

#### Q: IS HEP A BARTER SYSTEM?

A: No, barter is direct trading, based on cash value, between two people. HEP exchanges are friendly, neighborly favors. An hour with a lawyer is the same as an hour with a carpenter.
